

## COASTAL DIVISION 03/31/2021 MEETING MINUTES

1. All teams will bat everyone who is physically able throughout each game.
2. Run-to Rule will be followed, however each manager will review and emphasize the Manual rule that requires the runner to avoid contact on the basepath at all times. The managers agree that a dangerous baserunner will be issued either a warning, or assessed an out, or result in a player's ejection.
3. Player's ejection can be issued by any one of the following: Umpire, Coastal President, by agreement of both gameday managers and/or the WSSA Commissioner.
4. Players ejected will be required to leave Ogden Park immediately and cannot return until the second game of the next playing date. Second ejections in a season will be initially handled by the Coastal managers and President and/or may be escalated to the BOD level.
5. Failure to comply with an ejection will lead to a team forfeit.
6. Infield Fly Rule will not be utilized in the 2021 season.
7. Teams with only 10 players or fewer may be required to provide their own catcher. (To be determined by the Coastal President and gameday managers).
8. Coastal Division will continue use of the bats that have been approved in past WSSA seasons: ASA Certified with 1.20 certification.
9. The June 2020 Core Teams will be a starting point for the 2021 Spring Training/Practice time.
10. The Coastal Draft will be scheduled for Tuesday, April 27.
11. The Coastal President and Managers will decide how the draft will be conducted once we have obtained the updated roster of 2021 players. Team balance will be of paramount importance.
